**Safeguarding Policy**  
**This update 12<sup>th</sup> March 2026**  
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### **Introduction**

Reddish Events recognises that the protection of children and vulnerable people is a particularly important area, supporting and developing good practice and safe activities for children and vulnerable people in such a manner as to ensure their physical and emotional well-being.

Reddish Events are however by clear definition, a committee that supports events organisers, and in this role there is no foreseen direct contact with, voluntary or professional role working with children and / or vulnerable people.

Our policy therefore sets out our role in supporting safeguarding leads provided by event organisers.

### **The Aims of this Policy**

This policy ensures that Reddish Events committee are clear about their responsibilities and the actions necessary with regard to child protection issues.

The policy aims are:

- To raise the awareness of our committee members of safeguarding issues and protocol.
- To ensure that committee members are aware of the policies and procedures of [The Stockport Safeguarding Children Partnership](#).
- To identify responsibility in reporting possible cases of abuse

### **Implementation of this Policy**

- For each event supported by Reddish Events where volunteers and professional staff are working with children and / or vulnerable people, a designated safeguarding lead and safeguarding policy must be in place, provided by the event organiser, and this must be written up an integral part of any agreement.

- For each of these events, the committee is to nominate a designated representative of Reddish Events to support the designated safeguarding lead, and where necessary safeguarding teams in local authority.
- Reddish Events committee are to ensure effective communication with all safeguarding partners
